

Severe risk area has been added for mainly the risk for isolated tornadoes.

Our Forecast

Tropical Depression Cristobal is currently located across southeastern Mexico. The system is predicted to move toward the northern Gulf Coast this weekend. Landfall is forecast to occur in south-central Louisiana near Vermilion Bay late Sunday night into early Monday morning. However, conditions will deteriorate well before the center moves onshore. Winds at landfall are forecast to be near 60 mph. In addition, we expect that the system will be rather broad, with strong winds extending well away from the center.

Rainfall amounts of up to 8 inches could occur. Tidal surges could exceed 6 feet.

Main Impacts

Wind:

Power outages will likely occur in areas that receive strong winds.

Rain:

At a minimum, street flooding could result in travel delays.

Surge:

At a minimum, coastal flooding could occur.
